In 1901, Gustav Stickley founded The Craftsman, a periodical that began by expounding the philosophy of the English Arts & Crafts movement with an American spin. His influence and ideas about domestic organic architecture lead to many turn of the century Bungalows as well as the "mission style" oak furniture look associated with both Craftsman and Arts and Crafts styles.
